We purchase our power from Hoosier Energy REC, which is headquartered in Bloomington, Indiana. Hoosier Energy is a Generating and Transmission Cooperative owned and controlled by 17 rural electrics in the southern and central parts of Indiana that receive electricity from that organization.

The REMC has historically acted as an 'energy source' to spur economic growth in our communities and to create a better style of living. Our mission continues to be to provide reliable electricity and services to our members. This includes working toward the future, meeting the demands of our member/owners, being good stewards of our environment and being a good corporate, community citizen.
